Circular trail from the top station of the Ehrwalder Almbahn cable car to lake Almsee with opportunities for playing and fun. Suitable for prams.

LERMOOS

Moosle's explorer trail

With 7 research stations, Moosle's explorer trail offers fun and entertainment for the whole family. Easy to walk, but not suitable for prams throughout.

Moosle's magic forest

An interactive play and adventure trail with 9 stations for the whole family. Easy to walk, but not suitable for prams throughout.

BERWANG

Educational nature trail Mitteregg

Experience the adventures of the little eagle Horsti with all his attractions: wooden ball track, water sounds, wooden bowling alley, Horsti's grass and fun slide, and much more besides.

BIBERWIER

Beaver trail Biberwier

Educational moor trail
